THEME: Culminating Project Packet

NAVIGATION 101:

CLEAR, CAREFUL, AND CREATIVE PLANNING FOR LIFE BEYOND HIGH SCHOOL

Announcements:

Culminating Project Presentations are April 21. Project proposals must be turned in by the next Advisory on October 1.

Lesson Goals:

1. Conduct a brief survey for Navigation 101 Grant.
2. Update the culminating project packet with a new page 4 so students have the due dates and know the date of presentation.
3. Give students the dates of the SAT and fees.

ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS:

What do I need to do my senior year?

CLASSROOM ACTIVITY 1:

Navigation 101 Survey (3-5 minutes)

Pass out the survey handouts to students and allow them to complete the survey. Collect surveys upon completion. Please turn in to Tammy Hill after Advisory today.

CLASSROOM ACTIVITY 2:

Culminating Project Packet Review (15 minutes)

- Hand out the Senior Checklist and page 4 to replace the page in the packet students received last advisory of last year. Discuss with them due dates for all activities. Give special emphasis to the fact that Culminating Project Presentations will be **April 21**. All project proposals and other paperwork must be approved by the advisor by or on **October 1**.

- Students need to have the following forms filled out completely and approved by their advisor and the coordinator **before** they can begin their project
 1. “Culminating Project Proposal” (2 pages) Pgs. 7&8
 2. “Parent/Guardian Consent” Form” Pg. 13
 3. Form at the bottom of the “Culminating Project Guidelines” **if** the student is doing a job shadow or volunteering for an organization Pg. 14
- Review “Culminating Project Guidelines”(page 14) with students
- The Senior Checklist should be placed in the front pocket of the student’s binder.

**CLASSROOM
ACTIVITY 3:**

SAT Dates and Fees (*10 minutes*)

Distribute the SAT handout and have students put them in their portfolios. Explain to them that even if they took the SAT last Spring, college bound students around the nation usually retake the test in the Fall of their Senior year because scores usually go up due to maturity and familiarity with the test. Even if they have not practiced over the summer or taken further course work, scores tend to go up. Point out that the next sign-up deadline is September 23rd for the October 10th test. Note that this would be considered a late registration.

ASSESSMENT:

1 point for participation, 1 point for turning in completed survey and placing paperwork in portfolio.

Important Information About U.S. Registration

- U.S. deadlines apply to students testing in the United States, U.S. territories, and U.S. commonwealths
- U.S. registration materials that are mailed must be postmarked by the U.S. deadlines.
- On March 13, only the SAT is offered.

Registering Late

If you are testing in the United States, U.S. territories, or U.S. commonwealths, and you miss the registration deadline, you still have time to submit a registration, but **you must pay a late fee**. Note that late registrations made by mail have a different deadline from those made by phone or online.
