Reminders:

Be sure to check on the DPHS website under the Stag's LEAP link to get lesson information and handouts for advisory sessions that you may miss this year. As a junior it is important to get and keep your binder up to date, so you don't have to worry about it your senior year when you are working on your culminating project.

Remember to choose two work samples from this semester.

Teachers: Be sure to set-up your Skyward Advisory page to weight the SLC as 50% of the total grade and enter credit for those who completed their conference. If you have students who have not completed their conference, please clean these up within the next week. Students cannot pass Advisory without the successful completion of the conference.

Lesson Goals:

- Review the details of the Culminating Project

MATERIALS NEEDED:

SLC Reflection (1 per student)
Culminating Project Packet (some of your students may already have one) \$2 after this. Place in binders of students who are absent.

CLASSROOM REVIEW:

De-brief with a class discussion on the student-led conferences. Discuss observed high points and low points. Remind students of the need to expand on their presentations and include details of their culminating project for next year. Then distribute the **SLC Reflection**, have them complete it and file it in the Personal and Social Development Section

CLASSROOM ACTIVITY 1:

It is recommended that you take the time to read the complete packet prior to Advisory so that you can answer questions informatively.

Distribute the Culminating Project Packet to each student. Take the time to walk through each page so that all understand the requirements, and just as importantly, the required protocols and paperwork. **Students are not allowed to begin their projects without first completing all the necessary forms and obtaining all the necessary approvals.**

This means students must have all approvals and paperwork prior to leaving for the summer if they plan on doing the project over the summer.

Students are responsible for replacing any lost packets. You should not feel compelled to do this for them. Replacements for lost packets can be purchased from Tammy Hill for \$2 or may be printed from the high school website on a home computer.

Extra Time (?)

Not all of my students had their portfolios together. You might want to check all of your students portfolios. Tell them their senior year will go better if they stay organized.
